High School. Manchester High School was formerly named South Manchester High School, from which the name Somanhis (So-Man-Hi-S) was derived. Classes met at the former Grammar School until 1905 when a four-story building opened at 1146 Main Street. The high school moved to 134 East Middle Turnpike in 1956.
